## **Dispose of it**

Residents who live west of Antioch and have weekly curbside trash service should start making plans for the annual large item trash pickup.

Each year Overland Park schedules a large item trash service for about half the community. Last year, residents east of Antioch received this service.

The schedule for the residences west of Antioch is: Saturday, April 6, 2002 north of 99th Street.

Collection begins at 7 a.m. on the designated day of pickup for identified areas. Items should be at the curb no earlier than the day before, and no later than 7 a.m. of the pickup day. No follow-up collections are scheduled for this year.

Items you may dispose of include:

- appliances
- car parts (no engines or fuel tanks)
- tires not mounted on wheels
- brush and tree limbs that are no longer than 4 feet in length and are **bundled**
- railroad ties (four feet or less)
- remodeling debris
- furniture

No hazardous material or liquid waste will be accepted.

As of January 28, we have received the 2002 dues for 232 homes, leaving a remainder of 224 that still owe \$ 111.00 by February 1st. Please make sure your check arrives at PO Box 12112 OP, KS 66282 before February 15th so that you don't have to pay the \$10 Late Fee or have your Trash Service interrupted. If you have special circumstances, please call Rachel at 913-652-0189 immediately.

The approximate breakdown of the \$111 per house is : \$95 for Trash pick-up, \$6.50 for Insurance, \$3 for general office and admin. expenses, \$2.50 for Savings to keep the same dues amount for the next year or so, \$2 for Postage, \$1 for Printing, and \$1 for parties.
