Changes Coming to Trash Service in 2012

Overland Park has issued a new city ordinance that requires trash and recycling service to be bundled and offered to all residents. Consequently, the new trash contract for Morningview will include **recycling for all residents as well as trash service. We will also contract for yard waste pickup and disposal.** The yearly dues will include the cost for

all three services. This means that if you currently recycle on an individual basis with a company that is the Morningview hauler (Town and Country), then you will need to cancel your contract with your current hauler (if you chose) as your dues would already include recycling. **Every resident will receive a trash bin and a recycle bin from Town and**

Country some time before 2012.

Morningview solicited bids for the 2012 year and discussed service at the last meeting. A deal was negotiated with Town and Country for the next few years that meets the city's new ordinances and keeps our dues at a reasonable level. Please join us at the meeting if you have any questions regarding the changes.

Burn Ban in effect for Overland Park

Per the Overland Park Fire Marshal, all burning in Overland Park is banned, due to low humidity and extremely dry conditions. Both open burning and recreational fires (which includes Fire Pits, portable Fire Pits, Chiminea, and Tiki Torches) is prohibited until further notice. All issued burn permits are suspended until further notice. Anyone caught burning during this ban can be issued a \$500 fine and ordered to appear in court.
