Changes Coming to Trash Service in 2012

Overland Park has issued a new city ordinance that requires trash and recycling service to be bundled and offered to all residents. Consequently, the new trash contract for Morningview will include recycling for all residents as well as trash service. We will also contract for yard waste pickup and disposal. The yearly dues will include the cost for all three services.

This means that if you currently recycle on an individual basis with a company whose bid is not chosen as the Morningview hauler, then you would need to cancel your contract with your current hauler (if you chose) as your dues would already include recycling. Every resident will receive a recycle bin

from our 2012 trash hauler sometime before 2012.

Here is the gist of the new ordinance:

Your Part: Solid Waste and Recyclable must be stored in a container that is leak proof and rain-proof, lightweight container not exceeding 96 gallons in size. The container must be closed at all times except when depositing solid waste or recyclables. The area surrounding the containers must be kept in a clean, neat, and sanitary condition at all times.

Our Trash Haulers Part:

Solid waste and recyclables must be collected weekly and the charge for unlimited collection of recyclables and the container will be included

in the basic service charge. Yard waste is also included in the basic charge however the hauler can charge extra for more yard waste. Yard waste will be required to be picked up a minimum of 40 weeks a year.
